

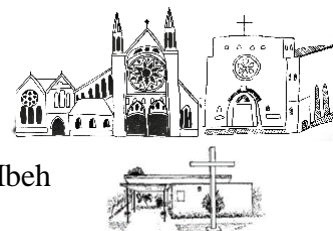

**The Lifting of Lockdown Restrictions and the Government's Call for Personal Responsibility:** The Prime Minister indicated on Monday that he envisaged lockdown restrictions in England being lifted from Monday 19th July. This decision is expected to be confirmed on Monday. In the light of local circumstances, we will be considering something of a phased return to normality, rather than seeking to return to all prelock down practice on Sunday 25th July. We are expecting further guidance on this.

**World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly:** The Holy Father has designated Sunday 25th July to be a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, at which we are all invited to celebrate and give thanks for the role and contribution of grandparents and older people to their families and our parishes.

**On that Sunday:** • At Mass, the homily and prayers will focus on grandparents and the elderly;

- Children of the parish are encouraged to attend Mass together with their grandparents;
- Copies of Pope Francis' message for the Day, 'I am with you always', will be available for those attending and also for delivery to grandparents and the elderly who cannot attend Mass;
- All are encouraged to make a visit to the elderly living alone in the community.

**Ordinations:** Please remember in your prayers the three men preparing to be ordained priests for our Diocese at Saint Anthony's Wythenshawe next Friday; and the two candidates preparing to be ordained to the Permanent Diaconate at Saint Michael and All Angels, Woodchurch on 24nd July.
